

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR FINAL REGISTRATION TO ASSOCIATE AND BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMS

FOR ASSOCIATE AND BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMS:

1. **Diploma:** Original high school diploma and its notarized Turkish translation approved by the Turkish Embassy, Consulate, or a Notary Public.
2. **Transcript** (Academic Records): Original transcript and its notarized Turkish translation approved by the Turkish Embassy, Consulate, or a Notary Public.
3. **Equivalency Certificate:** A document issued by the Turkish Ministry of National Education or the Turkish Embassy/Consulate in the applicant's home country, certifying that the high school diploma is equivalent to those issued by Turkish high schools.
4. **Exam Result Document:** The original exam result document used for the application (KÜNYÖS, SAT, TR-YÖS).
5. **Passport:** A notarized copy of the passport showing nationality, with at least 6 months of validity.
6. Candidates with dual citizenship (one of which is Turkish) who completed their entire high school education abroad (excluding TRNC high schools) via formal education are required to submit a clear and legible copy of the passport pages showing entry and exit to/from the country where the diploma was obtained, or an official **entry-exit document obtained** from the Directorate of Security in Turkey.
7. Two biometric **photos** (size: 4.5 x 6 cm).
8. **TÖMER Certificate:** A document showing Turkish language proficiency or a certificate indicating at least B1 level.
9. Blue Card: A photocopy of the Blue Card for students who hold one.
10. Temporary Protection ID Card: A photocopy of the international temporary protection card for students accepted under this status.
11. Civil Registry Record (**Vukuatlı Nüfus Kayıt Örneği**): Required from dual citizens or those who acquired Turkish citizenship later, showing that both citizenships are valid as of the final registration date.
12. In accordance with the "Cooperation Protocol on Residence Permit Applications of International Students" signed between the Council of Higher Education and the Directorate General of Migration Management on November 15, 2023:
 - The passport page showing the border crossing stamp
 - The visa sticker in the passport (except for those exempt from visa)
 - One of the following documents: residence permit card, stateless person permit, international protection application/status document, temporary protection ID card, or work permit
14. **Tuition Fee Receipt**

Terms and Conditions;

.1. Applicants to Health and Aviation programs must meet the specific requirements and conditions of the relevant department/program.

2. Applicants who do not have a TYS (Turkish Proficiency Exam) certificate are required to take the Turkish Proficiency Exam administered by Cappadocia University.

Except for applicants who hold a high school diploma issued by the Turkish Ministry of National Education.
